Keystone Proficient Pathway

Prepare to Graduate: Show up. Do Your Work

KEYSTONE EXAMS COUNT

- Passing your Keystone courses and exams is the most direct route to graduation.
- Take and Pass Keystone Courses: Biology (9 or 10), Algebra 1 (9) and Literature (10)

RHS Credit Requirements

- 4 English
- 4 Math
- 3 Science
- 3 Social Studies
- 1.5 PE
- 0.5 Health
- Total of 24 Credits 8 Electives

Keystone Composite Pathway

Prepare to Graduate: Show up. Do Your Work

Take and Pass Keystone Courses: Biology (9or 10), Algebra 1 (9) and Literature (10)

RHS Credit Requirements

- 3 Social Studies
- 4 English 4 Math
- 1.5 PE
- 0.5 Health
- 8 Electives

- Earn a Proficient score one of the Keystone exams: Algebra I, Literature, or Biology.
- Earn a total score of 4453 on the three Keystone exams (at least one of the scores must be Proficient/Advanced and no less than a basic score on the remaining two).
- For any Keystone exam that does not score Proficient/Advanced, student must earn a passing grade in an equivalent class associated with that Keystone exam





CREDITS COUNT.

- Show up.
- Do your work.
- Pass your classes.
- Earn 24 Credits

Take and Pass all Keystone Courses:

- Biology (9th or 10th grade)
 Algebra 1 (9th grade)
 Literature (10th grade)

Alternative Assessment Pathway

Prepare to Graduate: Show up. Do Your Work

- Earn a passing grade on classes associated with each Keystone exam
 - Biology
 - Algebra I
 - > Literature 10
- Show one piece of evidence that displays career and college readiness.

RHS Credit Requirements

- 4 English
- 4 Math
- 3 Science
- 3 Social Studies
- 1.5 PE
- 0.5 Health
- 8 Electives



Evidence Displaying College & Career Readiness

One Piece of Evidence showing the ability to enroll in college level coursework

- SAT 1010
- PSAT 970
- ACT 21
- ASVAB 31
- AP 3 or higher on any AP exam
- Successful completion of Dual Enrollment Course
- Accepted in an accredited 4-year non-profit institution of higher learning.

Evidence Based Pathway

Prepare to Graduate: Show up. Do Your Work

- Earn a passing grade on classes associated with each Keystone exam: Biology,
 Algebra I and Literature 10.
- Enroll in Career and College course second semester of your fourth year of high school
- Demonstrate career and college readiness through three pieces of evidence from the student's career portfolio, aligned to student goals and career plan.

RHS Credit Requirements

- 4 English
- 3 Social Studies
- 4 Math
- 1.5 PE
- 3 Science
- 0.5 Health
 - 8 Electives



Career and College Planning Course

Seniors who did not meet graduation requirements in one of the other pathways will be placed in a Career and College Planning Course scheduled for 2nd semester their senior year to meet graduation requirements for the Evidenced-base pathway.


- Curriculum will include assignments that will meet new requirements.
- Students will receive 0.5 elective credit.
- Students will need to complete 3 pieces of evidence



Evidence Meeting Evidence-Base Pathway Requirements

At least one of the following:

- 3 or more on AP exam.
- Pass a dual-enrollment course.
- Attain an industry-recognized credential.
- Silver on ACT WorkKeys.
- Acceptance to a 2-year post-secondary school.



No more than 2 of the following:

- Proficient on any Keystone
- 10-hour service learning project (Jr. ROTC, KeyClub, Community Knights, or outside the organization).
- Letter stating full-time employment
- Military enlistment
- Complete internship or coop class
- 2.0 GPA



Career and Technical Pathway (CTE)

Prepare to Graduate: Show up. Do Your Work

- Earn a passing grade on classes associated with each Keystone exam: Biology, Algebra I and Literature 10.
- Pass the approved CTE concentration program at Reading Muhlenburg Career and **Technology Center (RMCTC).**

RHS Credit Requirements

- 3 Social Studies
- 4 English 1.5 PE
- 4 Math 0.5 Health
- 3 Science 8 Electives






IEP Goals and Other Circumstances

 The new graduation requirements allows the Reading School District Superintendent to waive the requirements on a case-by-case basis for a 12th-grade student or extenuating circumstances.

 Students who receive waivers must still meet local grade requirements.
